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Centre for Neuro Skills San Francisco Facility Awarded a Three Year Accreditation by CARF International

(Bakersfield, CA) Feb. 9, 2016 – Centre for Neuro Skills (CNS) announced that its San Francisco, CA facility has been accredited for a period of three years by CARF International (formerly Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities). CARF International is an independent, nonprofit accrediting body whose mission is to promote the quality, value and optimal outcomes of services through a consultative accreditation process and continuous improvement that centers on enhancing the lives of persons served. The CARF survey was conducted in 2015, and accreditation will extend through November 2018. The facility is located north of San Francisco in Emeryville, CA.

Accreditation demonstrates that CNS has opened its service delivery and business processes to outside review to ensure that services are of the highest possible quality. Programs awarded accreditation included:

- Residential Rehabilitation Programs: Brain Injury Specialty Program (Adults)
- Interdisciplinary Outpatient Medical Rehabilitation Programs: Brain Injury Specialty Programs (Adults, Children and Adolescents)

During the rigorous on-site peer review process, CNS demonstrated to a team of surveyors its commitment to offering programs and services that are measurable, accountable, and of the highest quality. Exemplary conformance to the standards was noted in two areas, a) in the provision of resources for staff education through the Research Department, and, b) for a newly developed and extensive clinical training process and manual.
