CNS Research Director Speaks at International Neurotrauma Symposium

Dr. Griesbach holds a Ph.D. in psychology and behavioral neuroscience with a minor in clinical neuropsychology from the University of Texas at Austin. She completed her post-doctoral studies at the University of California, Los Angeles. Her research focuses on understanding how the pathophysiology of traumatic brain injury influences experience-dependent plasticity. Dr. Griesbach leads the CNS research department, which strives to improve treatment and, consequently, outcome after brain injury.

Within the past year, Dr. Griesbach was also part of the invited faculty at the National Neurotrauma Meeting and the 3rd Annual Sport Concussion Symposium.
